



## **AMENDMENT TO STUDENT POLICY RELATED TO COVID-19**

1. **Purpose.**

This Amendment is to modify certain sections of the "Student Policy Related to COVID-19" adopted by the Board of Directors of Franklin Academy Foundation, Inc. on September 10, 2020 (the "Policy"). Unless specifically modified by this Amendment, the Policy shall remain in full force and effect until modified by the Board.

2. Subsection a.xi. of Section 3, **Safety Guidelines**, is hereby replaced with the following language:

"xi. be placed in Franklin From Afar if testing COVID-19 positive, or being exposed to COVID-19 positive case. This may result from a report from a parent or guardian, the local Florida Department of Health, or the campus reporting of a positive COVID-19 case on campus. For purposes of this section, exposure is close contact of 6 feet or less for 15 minutes or more **over a 24-hour period**. Contact at greater than 6 feet or for less than 15 minutes **over a 24-hour period** is generally not sufficient to transmit COVID-19."

3. Subsection b.iii. of Section 4, **Responsibilities of Students, Families and Staff**, is hereby replaced with the following language.

"iii. A student who tests positive must remain home and be enrolled in Franklin From Afar until the student meets the criteria to return to campus. A student who has tested positive for COVID-19 may return to campus when each of the 4 criteria is met:

1. at least 10 days have passed since symptom onset (20 days if illness is severe);
2. at least 24 hours have passed since resolution of fever (100.4 or higher) without the use of fever-reducing medicine;
3. other symptoms have improved; and
4. the student tests negative for COVID-19 between 10-12 days after symptom onset or the date student took test that yielded positive COVID-19 result."
