Club Descriptions:

Basketball Club (Grades 2,3,4,5) - Students will learn the basic skills to play basketball. They will learn to pass, dribble, shoot, and work with teammates to reach a common goal.

Cheerleading Club (Grades K,1,2,3,4,5) - LET'S GO PATRIOTS! Get fired up and learn cheerleading foundations. We will learn cheerleading motions, Patriot cheers and jumps. T-Shirt and Pom-Poms included in the club price.

Cooking Club (Grades K,1,2,3,4,5) – Teaching students the joy of cooking. Each week students will follow a recipe and work as a team to create a variety of fun foods. (14 Spots)
*** Please remember club is about an hour long and we do not have a stove or an oven to use.

Dodgeball & Gaga Club (Grades 2,3,4,5) – Its Dodgeball...what else needs to be said? Parents welcome!!! (40 Spots)

Lego Engineering Club (Grades K,1,2,3,4,5) – Lego teaches how to think in three dimensions—a precursor to physics. Children of all ages also hone creativity, problem-solving, and teamwork through Lego play and competitive builds. (20 Spots)

Reader's Theater (Grades K,1,2,3,4,5) – We will be using costumes and props to encourage reading and performing. We will decorate masks and create our own back-drop for skits! I also use games, choral reading, singing songs, and poetry to practice our reading fluency. This will increase our reading skills and confidence. (20 Spots)

Scooter / Games on Scooters Club (Grades K,1,2) – Students will do different activities on scooters include scooter soccer, relays, sharks and minnows, and even obstacle courses. (20 Spots)

Sign Language (Grades 2,3,4,5) – American Sign Language – The club provides insight on the culture. Students can learn sign language and the club also provides an environment for those already skilled in ASL to sign with others. (20 Spots)

Smash Bros. & Mario Cart Club - Come and play Nintendo's Smash Bros and Mario Cart with Coach D.

Soccer Club (Grades K,1,2,3,4,5) – Soccer is a great sport that teaches coordination, promotes teamwork, increases muscle and bone strength and helps to increase skills in concentration. At soccer club students will learn soccer rules, burn some energy and have fun. All at the same time! (20 Spots)

Ukulele Club (Grades 3,4,5) - Students will learn chords, strumming patterns and simple songs to be played and sung (modern and seasonal songs). Sheet music and reference material will be provided. The school has 16 ukuleles so spots are limited, but students with their own ukulele are guaranteed a spot. (up to 20 Spots)
