The PSAT/NMSQT is a standardized test administered by CollegeBoard and cosponsored by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC) in the United States. Approximately 3.5 million students take the PSAT/NMSQT each year. David's recognition will allow him to participate in the National Hispanic Recognition Program.
