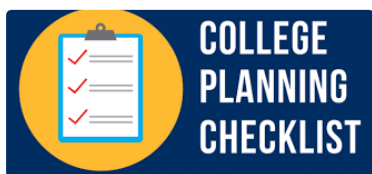

Required Parent Service Hours Tool

Franklin Families as a reminder, all parents MUST sign up to our new Service Hour Tool, Raptor. Please follow the instructions below:

1. Visit our school website at <https://pphs.franklin-academy.org/> to register for our new Service Hour Tool, Raptor. You will be able to check your service hours live and receive service hour opportunities as they are posted.

2. Once you are on the school website, on the left hand side you will see the FOR PARENTS icon towards the bottom. When you hover over it, the SERVICE HOURS link appears. Click on the link for FIRST-TIME PORTAL USERS. When you choose the FIRST -TIME PORTAL USERS, you will be directed to complete the volunteer application.
3. Service hour tracking will be a live feed for you to review hours you physically complete on campus. For service hours that are completed off campus, you will continue to complete the "18-19 Off Campus Service Hour Form" which is located on the same page of the the SERVICE HOUR link on our website."
