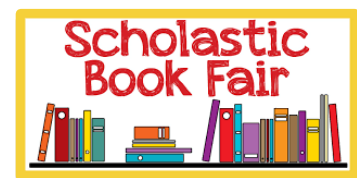

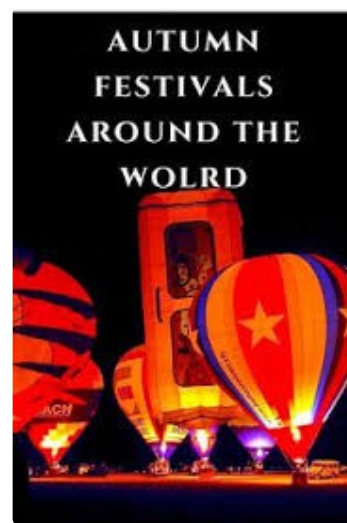
## Global Citizens Program- Dress Down Day, Sept. 27
