

# Algebra 1/Geometry EOC

## Quick Facts! 2020-2021

**Who takes it?** All students enrolled in and completing Algebra 1/Geometry. Middle grades students enrolled in Algebra 1 must take the Algebra 1/Geometry EOC assessment, not the grade-level mathematics assessment.

**What is it?** The Algebra 1/Geometry EOC is a computer-based test (CBT) that measures student achievement of the Florida Standards as outlined in their course descriptions.

### When and where is it administered?

The test will be administered at school during the course of the school day. The testing window for the Algebra 1/Geometry EOC is May 3–28, 2021. Specific dates for Franklin TBD.

### How is the test administered?

As previously mentioned, the Algebra 1/Geometry EOC is taken on a computer.

Paper-based versions of CBT assessments are provided for students with disabilities as specified in their Individual Educational Plans (IEP) or Section 504 Plans.

CBT accommodations (e.g., text-to-speech) are available for students whose IEPs or Section 504 Plans indicate these accommodations.

The assessment is administered in two 90-minute sessions over two days.

There are multiple test forms for each assessment, with a maximum of 68 items on each test form.

Students are provided CBT Work Folders for each EOC session.

A scientific calculator is provided as part of the CBT platform for Session 2 only of FSA EOC assessments.

**How is the test graded?** The EOC is graded on a scale of levels 1-5. Levels 3, 4, and 5 are passing scores.
