

## DUAL ENROLLMENT DEADLINE FOR SPRING SEMESTER IS OCTOBER 1<sup>ST</sup>

The Dual Enrollment Program at Broward College (BC) is an accelerated program that allows eligible public/charter, private and home school secondary students to take postsecondary coursework and simultaneously earn both high school and college credits, saving both time and money! Dual Enrollment students are exempt from the payment of application fees, tuition and laboratory fees. College courses are offered at BC campuses after school hours and through Broward College Online.

### Initial Eligibility

Dual Enrollment is open to all high school students but is recommended for students who have completed their 10th grade year of study. Students must have earned a minimum 3.0 unweighted high school grade point average (GPA) and meet the college level test scores in all areas – English, Reading and Math. ### Continued Eligibility

Students who are already part of the Dual Enrollment program at BC must meet the continued eligibility requirements of:

- Complete a **Dual Enrollment Recommendation Form** each term **by the deadline** with parent/legal guardian, student, school counselor and principal signatures
- Maintain a 3.0 unweighted high school GPA
- Maintain a 2.0 Broward College GPA
- Earn a grade of “C” or better in each college course
