FRANKLIN ACADEMY – 2025-26 STUDENT PARKING & DRIVING POLICIES

- In order for a student driver to leave campus early, the student MUST be queued via DashPass' early release feature. Parents MUST have DashPass to submit request. Emails will not be accepted.
- 2. Cars parked on campus must be registered with Franklin Academy and display a current parking permit. The vehicle's license plate must be visible at all times.
- 3. All students driving and parking on school property must hold a valid operator's license. All vehicles must be in safe operating condition as set forth by the State of Florida.
- 4. The speed limit on school grounds is **5 mph**. All drivers will obey the speed limit and follow the proper directions, signs, and indicated arrows on the roadway or lose parking privileges.
- 5. Students must use due care and respect for others in the operation of their vehicles. Students who operate vehicles in an unsafe or reckless manner on school property, on the streets adjacent to the school, around school buses, or while driving to and from school, may face disciplinary action. Loud stereos, radios, and faulty auto alarms will not be permitted and will result in the student's parking permit being revoked.
- 6. All vehicles must park with their front facing the wheel stop. NO BACKING IN! Parking on the grass, faculty parking lot or double parking is not permitted. Do not park any unauthorized area in the community at any time. (i.e. The Trails at Pembroke Pines). Parking regulations will be strictly enforced. Suspension or revocation of parking privileges, towing of the auto and/or suspension from school may occur for violations of these parking regulations.
- 7. If signing in late, you must report to the main office to sign in and obtain a tardy pass.
- 8. Students are not permitted to sit in vehicles in the parking lot during the school day. (**NO EXCEPTIONS**) This includes before, during and after school as well as during lunch. No loitering in the parking lot is permitted. Your car is not a locker. If an item is left in your vehicle, permission must be granted from an administrator in order for you to retrieve it.
- 9. Valuables should not be left in vehicles. ALL VEHICLES SHOULD BELOCKED!
- 10. Student Vehicles may be subject to search if there are reasonable grounds to believe that drugs, alcohol, stolen property, weapons, or other contraband might be present in that vehicle. Decal holders are responsible for all items found in their vehicle. Decal will be revoked if contraband is found.
- 11. Parking permits are NOT TRANSFERABLE to another vehicle or another student. **If a parking permit is found** in another vehicle, both parties lose their permits.
- 12. Students who do not maintain an unweighted 2.0 GPA or higher, have unexcused absences from class, and/or have discipline problems are subject to revocation of parking permit. Suspension from school may result in driving privileges being suspended and revoked.
- 13. If a replacement permit is needed, you must present the old permit prior to the issuance of a new one. If the permit was destroyed in an accident, a Police report must be presented to receive a new decal. Replacement/temporary permits should be taken care of by visiting the front desk prior to first period.
- 14. Franklin Academy shall not be responsible for damages to automobiles or other vehicles parked or operated on school property.

Parking rules and all road regulations are strictly enforced. It is considered a privilege to park on campus. The
administrative staff shall have the right to remove the parking permit of any student in violation of the above rules
and regulations or for any serious school rule infraction. I understand these rules apply before, during and after
school. Any violations are subject to disciplinary action.

SENIOR PARKING SPOT PAINTING

REQUEST FORM

If you would like to decorate your parking spot, the fee will be \$25 check or money order. If you do not follow the below guidelines and use an unapproved paint you will be subject to another fee of \$125 to help restore the parking stop back to its original condition.

What should you bring?

- You must provide your own paint and painting supplies (brushes, rollers, paint tape etc.). Bringing a broom to sweep off your spot before painting will save you lots of time
- Plan to buy one brush or roller for each color of paint you will be using.
- You must use latex exterior paint (water based).

UNAPPROVED PAINTS: ✓ No oil based paints ✓ No reflective paint ✓ No spray paint ✓ No fluorescent paint ✓ No paint sprayers ✓ No clear coat

- Do not use "Striping Paint" or any other "Raised" paint or Roofing Tar it either peels up or is difficult to paint over next year.
- Consider sharing paint with a friend.
- It is a good idea to bring chalk map out your design on the concrete before you begin painting.
- A towel or stadium seat



What about a design?

- Your design must be school appropriate; it cannot be in poor taste, lewd, obscene, or project a message of hate or intolerance. No business advertisements. No offensive language, pictures, or symbols. No negative or rude language.
- Violation of these rules may result in the repossession of your parking spot.
- You must paint inside the lines, and leave approximately 4 inches of unpainted border.
- Do not paint on the lines or the spot number stenciled on your parking spot.
- If you would like to collaborate with the students on one or both sides of you to create one continuous design, that is allowed, but please do not paint on the lines separating the parking spots.
- Search online for appropriate ideas and inspiration ("Senior Parking Painting Ideas").
