Arrival Procedures



- Drop-off Window: 7:45 am – 8:00 am
- Both sides of the building will be used for student drop-off
- Follow all staff directions for a safe and orderly process
- Cars will be directed to a specific entrance – no exceptions
- Students must open and close their own car doors
- Students will be socially distanced to enter the building
- A thermal imaging camera will scan students upon entry
- Students will report directly to class – no congregating
- Reasonable tardies will be waived for the first week



School Breakfast



- Pre-packaged breakfast meals will be available for pick-up as students enter the building
- Breakfast will consist of milk or juice and dry food items such as cereal bars, bagel, pop tart, etc.
- Options will not be available for breakfast
- Students will eat breakfast in the classroom
- All students are eligible for FREE meals through 12/31/20
- There is no need to deposit funds in student accounts



School Lunch



- Students may select from a hot or cold school lunch item (i.e. pizza or pizza craft-able); No customizations
- Students will travel to the cafeteria to pick up their lunch and return to the classroom to eat
- Lunch menu will be available online for 10/12/20
- Students should bring a healthy snack to eat at school
- Students may bring their own lunch. If so, students must be able to open all items (juice boxes, containers, etc.)
- If lunch is forgotten at home, students will be provided with school lunch; Drop-offs will not be accommodated
- All students are eligible for FREE meals through 12/31/20



Student Supplies



- Students will not be sharing any supplies and must bring their own pencils, pens, crayons, notebooks, and any other items requested by their teacher(s)
- Updated supply lists for Franklin LIVE and Franklin FLEX were sent electronically and posted on the school website
- Rolling bookbags will be permitted for students in K-3 ONLY; This exception is permissible under current circumstances
- Due to safety concerns, rolling bookbags are NOT permitted for students in grades 4-8
- Students must bring their electronic device to school daily to access e-textbooks and submit work electronically as physical work cannot be collected



Technology Devices



- Students must bring a **fully charged** device along with the **power cable** to school daily or on assigned FLEX day
- For personal devices, parents must electronically sign Franklin's ***Bring Your Own Device*** (BYOD) agreement form
- School-issued desktops will remain on campus; Laptops must be taken home daily for charging purposes
- Mobile devices may not be used on campus; School policy requires that cell phones are OFF and stored in a bookbag
- Unprecedented worldwide manufacturer issues have caused a delay in delivery of purchased devices
- You may add your name to the waitlist for a school-issued device. The link is available on our school website

Classroom Setting



- Desks will be spaced apart enabling social distancing
- Students are required to wear a mask at all times while inside the building; Refer to official policy for specific details
- Students will need a computer device each day on campus
- Teachers will be teaching live and virtually simultaneously
- MYP students will be housed in learning labs while they log into each of their respective classes virtually
- PE may take place indoors: live, virtually, or a combination
- Students may not change on campus; they may wear their PE uniform on days they are scheduled for PE class



Campus Protocols



- Visitors are not permitted on campus except by appointment
- Parent conferences and meetings will take place virtually, by appointment only
- Playground equipment may not be used or accessed
- Recess will consist of time outdoors and leisure activity while maintaining physical distance
- Lost and found storage will not be available
- Socially distanced emergency drills will be facilitated
- Tardies and early sign-outs will be processed curbside using a QR code scanning process; a mobile device is required



Special Updates

Uniform Policy



Students are required to fully comply with the established dress code (unlike Franklin From Afar where students are only required to wear a uniform top). Dress code will be enforced.

After School Connections



Franklin LIVE and FLEX students may register with After School Connections for aftercare services. **Registration deadline is Thursday, October 8.** FLEX students may only attend on days they are attending class on campus.

Instructional Model Change Requests



Instructional model selections may be changed twice per quarter and is **based on seating availability.** Requests to return to Franklin from Afar can always be accommodated.

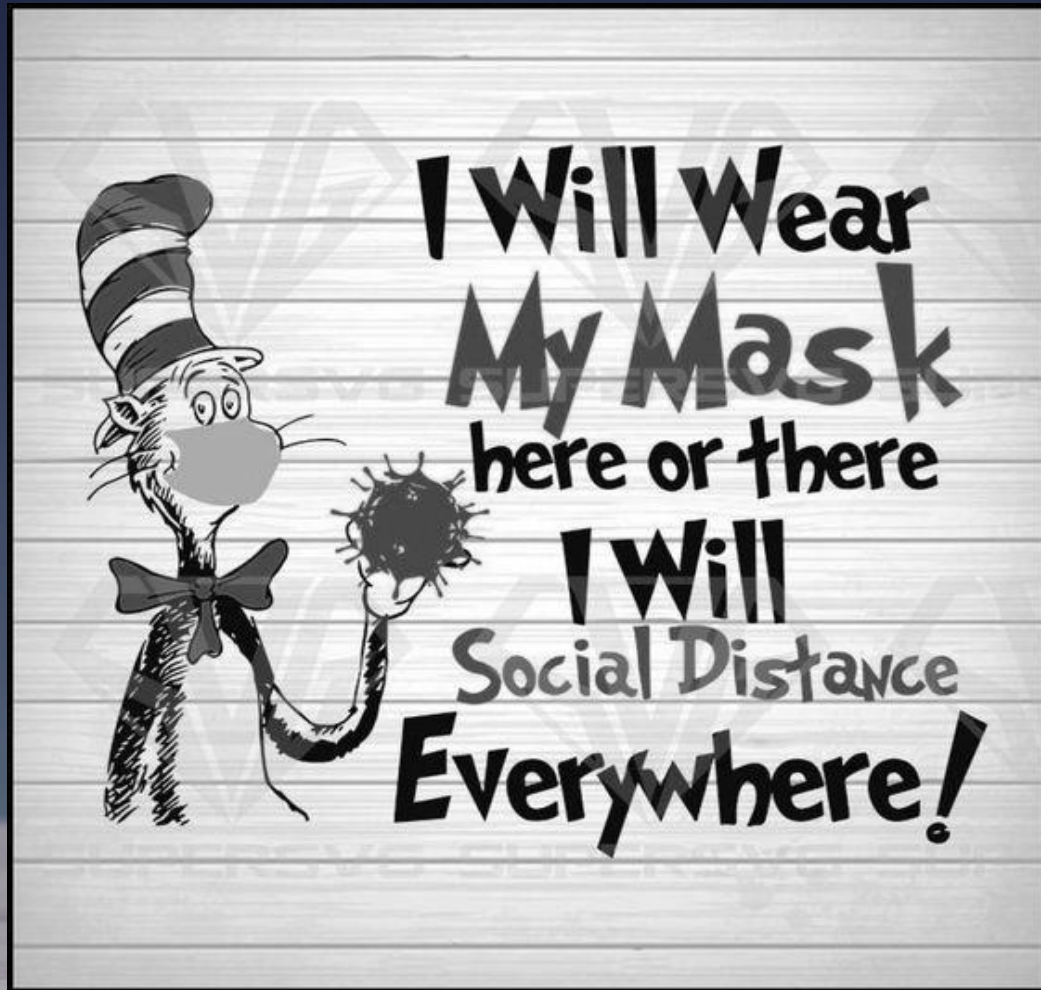

FULL POLICY ON SCHOOL WEBSITE



- ✓ All students are expected to follow face covering requirements while in school.
- ✓ A face covering is not required during mealtimes or while in designated outdoor spaces with physical distancing.
- ✓ Please speak with students and communicate expectations.

Parent Responsibilities

DAILY HOME SCREENING FOR STUDENTS

- ✓ Parents shall **provide facial coverings** for their student and ensure that they report to campus wearing a facial covering. *Neck gaiters, open-chin triangle bandanas, and mesh material, valves or holes of any kind are not acceptable face coverings.*
- ✓ No student will take **fever-reducing medicine** prior to the start of the school day.
- ✓ Please **keep students home** if they exhibit any of the following symptoms: *temperature 100.4 or higher, sore throat, cough, diarrhea, vomiting, abdominal pain, headache*
- ✓ Parent/guardian shall **promptly pick up** their child upon notification of fever and/or other COVID-19-related symptoms.
- ✓ Any self-reporting required by the COVID-19 Policy shall be submitted on the **COVID-19 Self-Reporting Form** available on our campus homepage.
