



Procedures for Public Comment and Input

The Board of Directors of the Florida Charter Foundation, Inc. (the "Foundation") conducts quarterly meetings in accordance with the requirements of Fla. Stat. §286.011 (Sunshine Law). Board meetings of the Foundation are open to the public, including parents, students, staff and other stakeholders. Although the Foundation does not have a process by which attendees may add items to the agenda in advance, all attendees are welcome to address any comments and/or input during the "Public Speakers" portion of the board meeting agenda, which immediately follows the opening Board Chair actions of calling the board meeting to order and taking a roll call to establish a quorum for the board meeting.

Each board meeting agenda shall designate "Public Speakers" as Agenda Item 3. Immediately following Roll Call, the Board Chair shall make the announcement quoted below, and then shall open the floor to any public speaker comments and concerns. For meeting efficiency, each such public speaker shall be limited to three (3) minutes.

Board Chair Announcement regarding Public Speaker Comment and Input:

"The Board of Directors of the Florida Charter Foundation, Inc. shall now open the floor for comment and input by anyone in attendance who would like to speak. For purposes of meeting efficiency, each speaker shall be limited to three (3) minutes.
