



## Start with Hello Week September 20-24, 2021

### 9/20 Mix-N-Mingle Monday:

- Students will be given a sticker to write their name and wear all day. They are encouraged to greet others (Hello John!)
- Encourage all students to sit with someone new at lunch or on the bus.

### 9/21 "Peace Across Broward Day"

- Wear a **WHITE** shirt to promote peace, tranquility, comfort, hope and unity.
- On "Peace Across Broward Day" @ 12 PM. Reflect for a minute for peace. At noon in each time zone around the world, a Peace Wave is created and becomes a shared act of peace building.
- What does peace mean to you? Pair up students to discuss and illustrate what "Peace Across Broward" would look like to them.

### 9/22 Wear Green Wednesday:

- As a symbol of Sandy Hook Promise, wear a **GREEN** shirt to promote unity and inclusivity.
- Classroom discussion: What makes you feel that YOU belong?
- Have your students create unique peace signs. Display the master pieces in the halls to inspire others as they walk by.

### 9/23 Teach Back Thursday:

- Watch the video on the 3 steps of Start with Hello then share what you learned with someone in your class.
  1. See Someone Alone.
  2. Reach Out and Help.
  3. Start With Hello!
- Give students 15 minutes to engage in a fun activity with a classmate they usually do not engage with. It can be a simple game of tic-tac-toe or connect the dots.

### 9/24 Funday Friday:

- It's important to say "Hello" to make everyone feel included. Teachers take a photo or video to share your student's fun and unique "Hello" style. Is it a high five, fist bump, elbow touch, or something else? Then share this with your school administrators, dean and counselor we can't wait to see it!
- Have students write a wish for peace on a sticky note and post it in a special place in your classroom.
