

## Child Care Opportunities in Response to COVID 19 School Closures for Verified Broward County Emergency, Medical, Hospital or Physician Office Employees Free of Charge

### Full Day Child Care – March 16, 2020 - March 20, 2020 – 7am – 6pm- Only

- Charter school students whose parents are Emergency, Medical, Hospital, or Physician Office Employees will have the opportunity to utilize the District’s Full Day Child Care - Free of Charge
- The charter school student must have their Broward County Student Identification Number or their Charter School ID Badge in order to register
- The parent of the charter school student will need to present an employee badge verifying their employment.

## FAQs

### 1. What is the cost?

- a. Services will be free for all eligible medical and emergency response employees.

### 2. Who will staff the program?

- a. Current before and after school childcare workers who are cleared and trained will be providing the childcare services at each site.

### 3. What about security?

- a. The School Board of Broward County's Safety and Security Department will provide security at each of the sites.

### 4. What about Food, breakfast and lunch?

- a. Please plan on the parent providing breakfast, lunch and a snack for Monday, March 16<sup>th</sup>. The district will Food and Nutrition Services is expecting to provide breakfast and lunch for the remainder of the week. Parents with children in the childcare program will be notified of all food service updates.

### 5. How will emergency services and medical professionals register their children for the program?

- a. An online registration database will be available Sunday, March 15<sup>th</sup> at 12:00 pm on the School Board of Broward County's Website.
- b. Parents will be asked to verify employment at the school site Monday morning.
- c. Parents will also be asked to verify that their child is a registered student at a Broward County District School or a Broward County sponsored Charter School. Verification will require a Broward County Public School student number and/or a student ID badge.
- d. If there are student medical conditions, parents must be ready to provide information so that program staff can support the student.

- e. If a parent does not sign up online, they may bring their child to one of the sites to register on the morning of Monday, March 16<sup>th</sup>.

**6. Will the schools have enough supplies and materials?**

- a. Yes, each of the sites has been providing childcare services after school and is already set up with supplies materials and staff to support the program. The School Board of Broward County will continue to support any needs.

**7. Will there be a nurse at each location?**

- a. Based on any medical conditions of registered students, a nurse may be provided.

**8. What dates and time does the program operate?**

- a. The childcare program is from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm, Monday through Friday, March 16<sup>th</sup> – March 20<sup>th</sup> at no cost to eligible students.
- b. Parents will need to pick up their children on time or face possible fines for late pick up.
- c. The program will not run during Spring Break March 23<sup>rd</sup> - March 28<sup>th</sup>, as that has been a scheduled time off in the District calendar.
- d. Further opportunities will be determined as the COVID-19 progresses.
