

### MYP Bell Schedule

The **expectation in our Franklin From Afar model is for your child** to follow these steps to participate in their fully virtual instructional school day:

1. Login to Clever **prior to 8:00 AM**.
2. Click on their Homeroom educator's Google Classroom.
3. Click on the Google Meet link on the top of their Homeroom educator's Google Classroom **to start their day**.

Your child is expected to transition to each **Period/Google Meet Instructional Session**, by utilizing the **Google Meet link** located at the top of each assigned educator's Google Classroom to receive **live instruction** and meet the state requirements of instructional learning time.

Your child is required to report to each class **on time, participate and remain for the entirety of each period**. Each educator will take attendance at the beginning of each period/Google Meet Instructional Session and checked at the conclusion of each.

- Attendance will be documented through PowerSchool for you to review upon logging into the PowerSchool Parent Portal or receiving the notification from PowerSchool.
- *The ONLY times in the MYP bell schedule school day where your child can **log out** is the **LUNCH BREAK 30 min, from 12:30 to 1:00 PM**.*
- During the **passing time** (6 or 7 min), your child will move from one Google Meet session to the next Google Meet session.
- During **LUNCH**, your child will log off at 12:30 PM and log in by 1:07 PM to attend their sixth period Google Meet session.
- For **A/B Courses** listed on your child's schedule, your child will login to the Google Meet session during the assigned period of the day that matches with the A/B schedule.
