Registration Forms & Payments

- Payments are only accepted by either a check or money order (**No online payments**): Made out to Franklin Academy.
- Payments **must be paper clipped** to the registration form.
- If you have an outstanding balance on your Franklin Academy account, you will not be able to enroll in a club until balance is paid.
- **A separate registration form and check or money order must be submitted for EACH club and EACH child**
- **The name of the club and the club moderator's name must be written in the memo line of each check or money order.**
- There are no refunds after **Monday, January 14th.** If your child is trying out for Sports please note there may be overlap in schedules. Speak to the coach about dates prior to signing up for clubs.
- Funds are not transferrable (**no club changes after Monday, January 14th, unless we cancel a club**)
- No late registration forms will be accepted.

LATE PICK UP POLICY

Please be advised that parents and guardians will be responsible for the pick-up of their child on the days in which their club meets, as transportation is not provided.

K-4th grade parents must pick-up their child by 4:00 PM and 5-8th grade parents must pick-up their child by 5:00 PM. There will be a \$1.00 per minute charge for late pick-up. Late pick up payments must be in the form of a check or money order and must be made out to Franklin Academy, not to the individual club moderator.
