- Virtual Zoom Meeting was called to order by Mr. Turano @ 4:34 PM. All attendees introduced themselves. Mr. Turano explained the mission and purpose of our SAC - Mission and Purpose of our SAC
 - According to Title 1 requirements pertaining to Accountability and Improvement, each school is required to have a School Advisory Council to **support the development and monitor progress** of the School Improvement Plan.
 - The SAC membership is designed to encompass stakeholders of different levels of involvement with the school **in the decision making process** such as School Administrators, Teachers, Parents, and Community Members.
 - The SIP provides us a strategic plan to **elevate student achievement**.
 - This is done through **needs assessments**, by **analyzing summative data** such as the FSA scores.
 - This year we don't have current FSA scores, however we can use past performance as a valid indicator. We are also able to use iReady data.

- After identifying those areas in need, we then **determine which strategies to implement** according to research-based best practices.
- We then look at how we will **monitor the progress** and the effectiveness of our efforts.
- We also will determine **how funds will be allocated** to support these initiatives.
