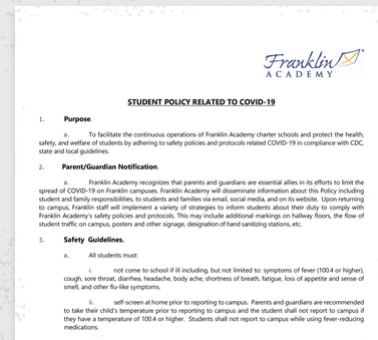

- Students Exposed to COVID-19 Positive Case



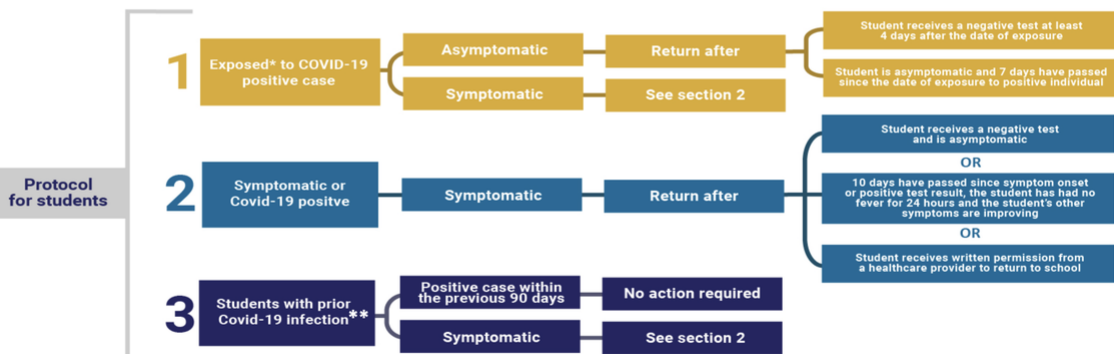

*Per CDC, exposure is close contact of 6 feet or less for 15 minutes or more. Contact at greater than 6 feet or for less than 15 minutes is generally not sufficient to transmit the virus.
**Per DOH 64DER21-12 this subsection applies equally to students that are fully vaccinated for COVID-19.

COVID-19 SELF-REPORTING FORM



This form is to be used by Franklin Academy staff, parents, students, vendors, volunteers and other community members. Self-isolation would be associated with exposure to someone with actual COVID-19 or having a positive test result. This information is needed to provide support to you or a student under your care, during self-isolation and to monitor the potential presence of COVID-19 in the schools. This information will not be used for any punitive or other negative consequences.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION RELATED TO COVID-19

- Learning will be 100% face to face on campus. No remote learning will be offered this school year.
- All students must face coverings at all times while on campus. A face covering shall not be required for any student outside of the school building while the student is engaged in physical activity provided that the student maintains physical distancing (six (6) feet minimum) from other persons when not wearing a face covering; when distancing measures are not possible, masks must be worn.
- School cafeteria will open for meal service through the traditional food service line.
- All sports and athletic facilities are now available.
- Franklin Academy will provide transportation services this school year.

- We are back to staggered arrivals and dismissals: Kinderarten-5th Grade: 7:30 AM to 2:15 PM, and MYP: 8:30 AM to 3:15 PM.
- Cleaning and disinfection of the school will be continued and everyone will be encouraged to do their part in preventing the spread of COVID-19 through frequent hand washing and staying home when sick.
